Lang's Master of Project Management (MPM) and Graduate Diploma in Project Management (GDip) programs provide enriching, professionally relevant, and flexible academic experiences in the field of project management. The programs provide opportunities to develop depth in areas of project management related to leadership, human resource management and sustainable business.

PROGRAM

You will gain the knowledge and skills to be able to tackle project leadership challenges facing your own organization. Coursework combines academic rigour of evidence-based management with real world applications to provide specialized project management training that supports project related managerial decision making.

The MPM program runs over 3 semesters (or 1 year). The GDip runs for 1 semester (or 4 months).

You will find a diverse range of topics including:

- Project Management
- Leadership Skills
- Project Governance
- Business Analytics
- Project Procurement and Supply Chain Management

The program features pedagogical approaches that consider seminar versus lecture formats, case-based teaching, and a focus on teamwork. The program is available in both full-time and part-time formats.

The delivery format allows students to complete some of the course requirements through intensive 7-week online courses and others through intensive weekly face-to-face courses. This provides the benefit of self-guided online learning with face-to-face instruction and opportunities for networking and student interaction.



ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Four-year undergraduate degree from a recognized university with at least B- average in your last two years of full-time study, and
- Minimum 2- 3 years of relevant work experience.

ADDITIONAL ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

- Online application form
- Statement of Interest
- Resume/CV
- Transcripts
- 2-3 Referee Assessments

Additionally, all applicants must meet the University of Guelph's English Language Proficiency requirements for admission. If an applicant's first language is not English, or their undergraduate degree was not taught at an English-language institution, an English Language Proficiency test will be required.

A GMAT is not required.
