ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Four-year undergraduate degree or its equivalent, with at least a B-average in your last two years of full-time study
- Work experience is not required, but preference is given to applicants with a demonstrated record of relevant work experience and/or experiential learning activities (e.g. co-op, internships, consulting projects).
- A GMAT/GRE is not required

Graduates of a 4-year undergraduate business degree (Bachelor of Commerce, Bachelor of Business Administration or equivalent) or who hold a professional designation (e.g., CPA, CFA, PMP) may be eligible for a waiver of certain program requirements, at the discretion of the MBA Program Coordinator.
