PROGRAM

Master's students can choose a course-based degree (8 months) or course work plus Major Research Project (MRP) degree (12 months). The MRP is completed in the third semester, supervised by a faculty member.

Students take core courses in macroeconomics, econometrics and asset pricing along with a balanced selection of economics and finance courses that suit their interests. Students are also required to take a non-credit preliminary mathematics course.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Undergraduate degree (4-year program or equivalent)
- B+ average in last two years of study
- Strong background in economic theory and econometrics
- Demonstrated familiarity with calculus, optimization and simple regressions
