PROGRAM

You will gain high-level strategic and analytical capabilities needed to be a forward-thinking leader, equipped to develop and implement sustainable solutions across complex global supply chains. This in-person 4.0 credit program combines foundational principles of supply chain and operations management with advanced studies in business analytics, sustainability and digital supply chain technologies, emphasizing hands-on, real-world applications.

The MSCM program runs over three semesters (or 10 months).

You will cover a diverse range of topics, including:

- Supply chain and operations management
- Logistics and transportation
- Digital supply chain technologies
- Business analytics
- Project procurement

STRUCTURE OF THE PROGRAM

Students benefit from experiential learning opportunities, including hands-on workshops, case studies and internationally recognized simulations. The program is available in both full-time and part-time formats, and all core courses will be delivered face-to-face.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Four-year honour's undergraduate degree or equivalent, from a recognized university or college, in business, engineering or a closely related discipline with a minimum 70% average during the final two years or four semesters of their study.
- A statement of interest, a resume/ CV, transcripts and two referee assessments are required with the online application form.
- Applicants must meet the University of Guelph's English Language Proficiency requirements for admission. If an applicant's first language is not English, or their undergraduate degree was not taught at an English-language institution, an English Language Proficiency test will be required.
- A GMAT is not required.
