Test Scores:

Courses at the University of Guelph are completed in approximately 12 weeks. Students therefore must be proficient in the use of English, both written and oral, when they begin their studies at Guelph. The university requires that certification of such proficiency be provided by applicants whose first language is not English. If you have successfully completed university level courses in a country where the first language is English you may be exempt from the language requirement.

Test results must be sent to the University of Guelph directly from the original source. However, if you have a photocopy of the test result you may submit this with your application package.

Additional Notes:

- individual departments may require higher scores than the university minimum average;
- test scores are valid from two years from test date;
- official scores must be submitted to the Office of Graduate Studies.

GRE or GMAT

Some departments/schools ask for additional test scores to provide more background to assess an applicant's suitability for entrance into a graduate program. The most common test requirements include the Graduate Record Examination (GRE) and Graduate Management Admissions Test (GMAT). Only some departments require such tests for admissions purposes.

It is the responsibility of the applicant to review the application requirements in their respective department of interest to determine if a GRE or a GMAT score is necessary to apply to the program. If a test score is required an official copy of the final score must be sent to the University of Guelph directly from the original source or with the application package. (Note: a photocopy of the test results may be included in your package, however official documentation must follow).
